### Petra - Amman

This morning visit the archaeological site of Petra, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the New 7 Wonders of the World. This afternoon, travel north to Amman. ### Amman - Excursion to Jerash, Ajloun and Anjara

Begin your day with a stop in Jerash, which was inhabited as early as 3200 BC. Although the city was impacted by the earthquake of 749 AD, it is the site of the best preserved Greco-Roman ruins in the Middle East.
